Below you will find a transfer credit report which provides information on how the coursework you have completed at other institutions will be applied at UMBC. What is shown reflects courses that have been evaluated to date and may not include information from transcripts submitted within the last two weeks.

Using the View Report button at the bottom of the screen you may request a degree audit report that shows how your transfer coursework will apply against general education and university requirements. In addition, beginning in October 2009 you will be able to request a degree audit report to see how your transfer coursework will be applied against major requirements.

Using the fields below, you have the option of modeling your transfer credit against different UMBC majors (Academic Plans). To generate this what-if report select an Academic Plan below (the default is the Academic Plan on your application).

UMBC academic policy allows a maximum of 90 units from all previous institutions and a maximum of 60 units (65 units for engineering majors) from two-year institutions to count toward a UMBC undergraduate degree.

If INFO NEEDED appears in the Equivalency Course column you must provide a complete catalog course description for your incoming course in order for transfer credit to be awarded. Submit this description to the Office of the Registrar. If an electronic description is available you may email it to records@umbc.edu.
