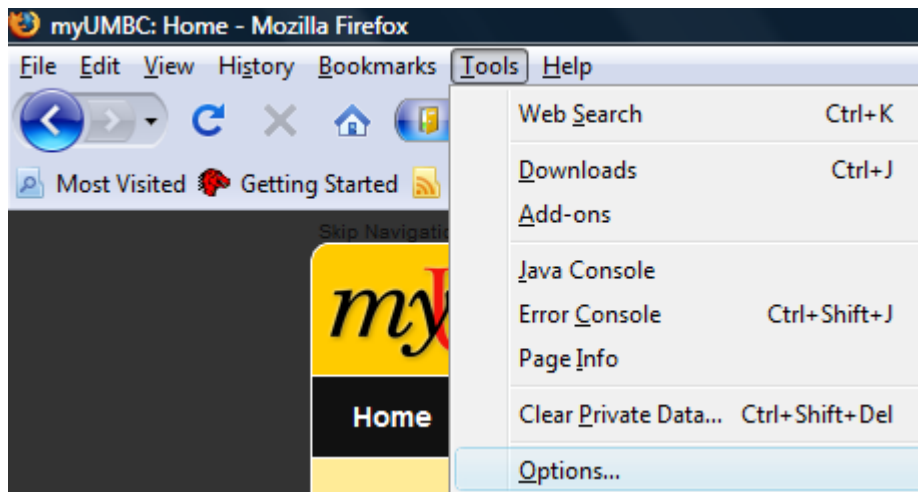


Allowing Pop-Up Windows in PeopleSoft

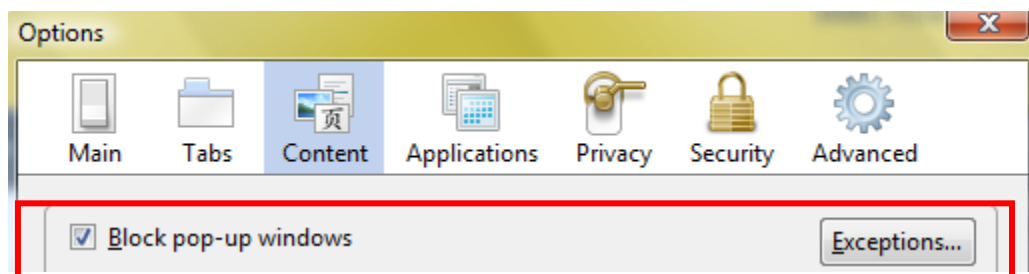
PeopleSoft often uses pop-up windows to display information you are requesting. If your browser is set to block pop-up windows—and most are set that way as a default—then PeopleSoft will not work properly. If you click on a button or a link and nothing happens, you probably need to adjust your pop-up blocker settings.

Allowing PeopleSoft Pop-Ups in Firefox 2 – PC or MAC Users

1. Open your Firefox browser.
2. Click the **Tools** menu. Select **Options**.



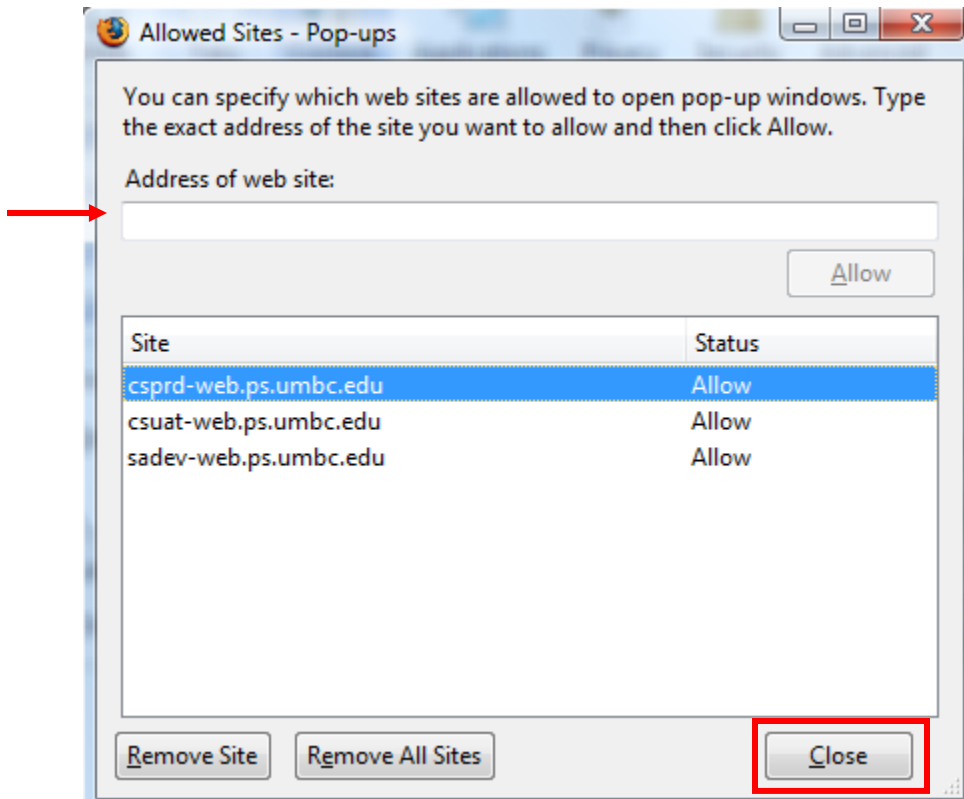
3. Click on the **Content** icon. Locate Block **pop-up windows**. (this option should be checked)



4. Click the **Exceptions** button.

5. The address of the website is **csprd-web.ps.umbc.edu**. If it is not already entered as an “allowed” site, enter the above address. Then click the **Allow** button.

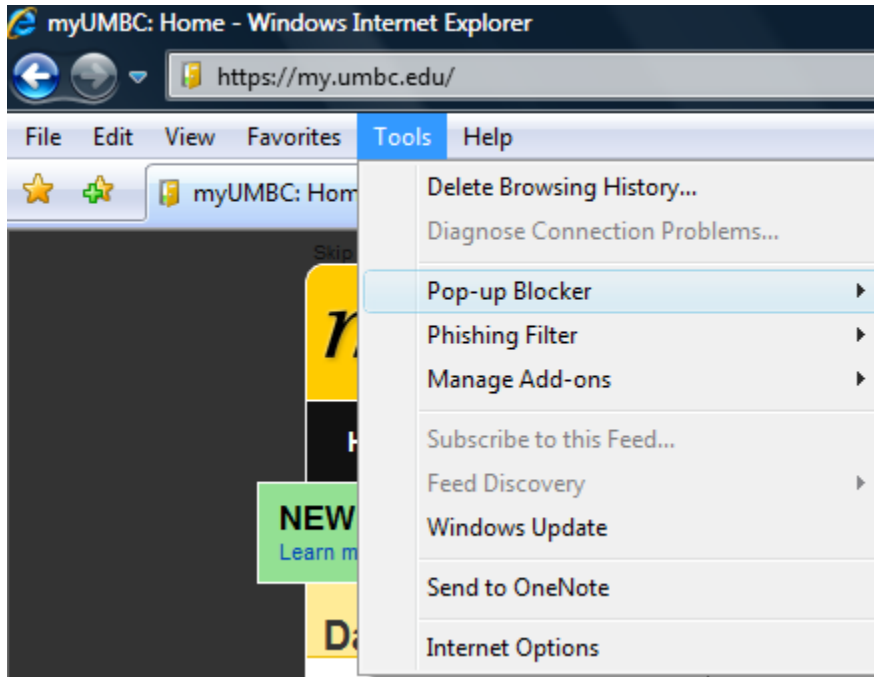


6. Click the **Close** button.

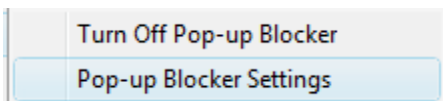
Allowing Pop-Up Windows in PeopleSoft

Allowing PeopleSoft Pop-ups in IE 7.

1. Open an Internet Explorer browser.
2. Click the **Tools** menu. Select **Pop-up Blocker**.

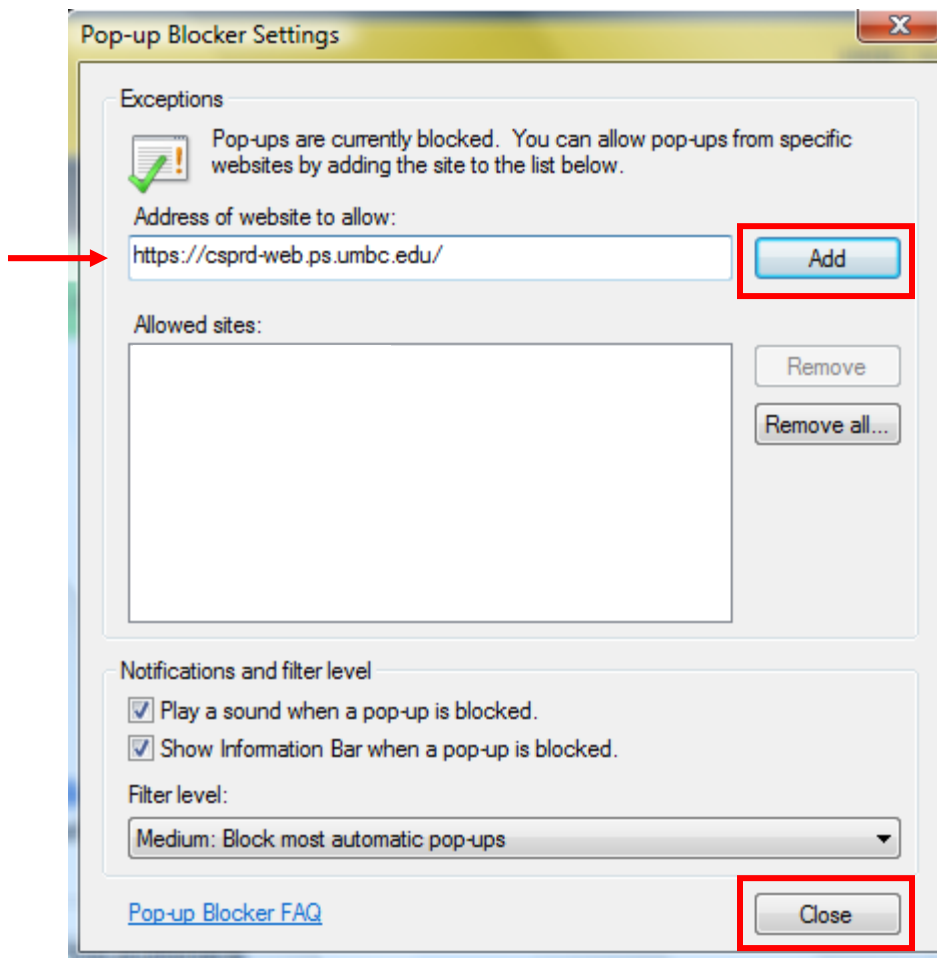


3. Select **Pop-up Blocker Settings**.

4. Enter <https://csprd-web.ps.umbc.edu>. Click **Add**.



5. Click **Close**.
